Children attending Pre K – 5th grade classes are not released until a parent or guardian checks them out after the Sunday School and Worship Hour ends.

All teachers and workers in our Children's Ministry have met the church's requirements, agreed to follow its policies, and have been through an approved background check.

## Wellness Policy

In order to keep the nursery a happy and healthy place for all children, we request that children be kept at home when they are ill or exhibit any of the following symptoms within 24 hours of church meetings. **Children should be symptom-free for 24 hours before leaving them in the nursery. Please when in doubt, keep them out!!**

1. Fever
2. Vomiting or diarrhea
3. Any symptoms of childhood diseases such as measles, mumps, chicken pox, whooping cough, etc.
4. Sore throat
5. Croup
6. Skin infection (rash, boils, ringworm, etc.)
7. Pink eye or other eye infection

**Workers and Volunteers are never allowed to administer any kind of medication to a child. This is the parent's responsibility.**

## SUNDAY SCHOOL HOUR

**Parents, please drop off and pick up your children at the following locations:**

### Upstairs

**K4 - 1st Grade—Room 202:** These young ones learn about God's Word and how it applies to their daily lives through Bible stories, play and crafts. We begin to lay the foundation for them to receive Christ and share the Good News of Jesus with others.

**2nd Grade - 5th Grade—Room 209:** The older children continue to build on their Christian foundation with Bible study, prayer and verse memorization. They learn about God's character and how they can follow Him.
